We have recently had a couple of issues at our concerts that I feel I need to address...

- 🔵 Please **DO** all in your power to **BE ON TIME** to all performances with your child. Kids are very embarrassed when they arrive late or miss performances completely, and this reflects upon our entire group.
- 🔵 Please **DON'T** allow your youngest children to wander freely or make excess noises during a concert. This greatly distracts our young performers and can affect the recordings we use for evaluations. If you have a very young child that may fuss or make noise during a song, please feel free to sit near the aisle or in the back so you can take them to the lobby if they become a distraction.
