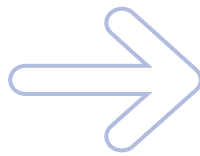

3 SIMPLE SCREENS... and you've created your free, secure **My 411** account.

Go to GACollege411 HOMEPAGE
Click "Create an Account."

SCREEN 1

Enter your name, birthdate, and email address.
Enter your user name, password, and password hint.

Option! You can use your GACollege411 account as your primary email.

SCREEN 2

Enter your mailing address and education level.
Indicate whether you would like to receive information updates.

Options! Add your parents' email address. You can add your high school counselor's name and email address for help with college planning, selection, and financial aid.

SCREEN 3

Your My 411 account is ready!

Now you can create a My 411 Profile for scholarship searches — and use your profile information to fill out college applications. Then find the college in Georgia that is right for you, begin your career planning, and find out about financial aid.
