

The Buford City Schools shall operate a school food service program to provide breakfast and lunch meals at a reasonable price that is approved by the City of Buford Board of Education.

The Board believes that a school environment that promotes and protects students' good health and wellness contributes to the overall academic success of students. Therefore, a Wellness Plan will be implemented that defines specific goals with regard to the following:

1. Nutrition Education
2. Nutrition Promotion
3. Physical Activity
4. Other school-based activities which promote student wellness
5. Nutrition guidelines for all foods available on school campus during the day (including fundraisers, competitive foods, and school nutrition program provided foods)
6. Measurements to determine the success of the schools in attaining the goals outlined in the Wellness Plan outlined in items 1 through 4.

The School District's designee shall coordinate the district's wellness efforts and make available to the public information regarding the content of and the schools' compliance with the Wellness Plan.
